CHICAGOLAND

A team from several CBA churches went to Chicago in January to do work of tearing out carpet, painting, laying down new floor, and assembling new bunk beds on the Chicago Metro Baptist Association building. This work will prepare the building to be used to host multiple teams coming to serve and share the gospel in Chicago.

A team from Northwest Indiana (part of the Chicagoland Partnership) came to the CBA the first week of January to do some renovation projects on Oaklands Restoration Church as well as sending out prayer teams to pray for several of our churches and staff.

Two teams from the CBA at the end of March will be participating in the Chicagoland Partnership - one will be returning to Chicago to work with Pastor Jorge Rodriguez of the Grace Family Church in Rogers Park. The other team will be headed to Northwest Indiana to work with Pastor Ralph Wilcox of the Portage Baptist Church and will be doing remodeling work on their fellowship hall.





REACHING SOUTH ASIA

A group from New Vision will be going to Kathmandu, Nepal, May 23-June 1, to work with children of IMB personnel (ages birth to 12th grade). The team will minister to the children through Bible study, recreation, encouragement, and fun, while their parents attend professional and strategic training to enable them to be better equipped to reach the vast lostness of South Asia.

A small team will be going to South Asia, April 21st-29th to train national church planters/pastors in what our IMB partners call the Great Commission Residency. The Great Commission Residency is a time (usually around 10 days) when leaders (usually 10-15) come to Mumbai for church planting and bible training.



THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Last summer, Mission Point and Blackman Baptist helped with the construction of the 4th Refugio Christian School addition. Though it isn't complete, it is already in use this semester. The addition is also one of the sites of December Christmas parties.
